



All plants are grown without chemical fertilizers or pesticides in our South Carolina-inspected and certified greenhouse.

Tomatoes \$4 each. All indeterminate, except Roma and Mountain Gold. All seeds are purchased from Heavenly Seed, LLC, in Anderson, SC.

Beefsteak (90 days): Extra-large (12 oz.) meaty, ribbed, deep-scarlet fruit.

Black Cherry (65 days): One-ounce black cherry tomatoes with rich tomato flavor.

Cherokee Purple (75 days): Medium to large fruit is dusky pink with dark shoulders. **Heirloom.**

Large Red Cherry (75 days): Produces clusters of large, red, flavorful cherry tomatoes about the size of a half dollar.

Moskvich (60 days): One of the most appealing extra-early tomatoes. Deep red tomatoes have a smooth texture and rich taste. Fruits average 4-6 oz., smooth and globe-shaped. Incredible flavor! **Organic, heirloom.**

Mountain Gold (72 days): Yellow-orange variety. Delicious, large (9oz.) firm, flattened-globe fruit that maintain their quality long after picking. Low acidity. Determinate bush. Not prone to cracking or blossom end rot.

Pink Brandywine (85 days): This old Amish heirloom dates back to 1885. Large pink fruit. **Heirloom.**

Roma (75 days): Excellent variety for the home garden. Block, red 3" long plum-shaped fruit are meaty with fewer seeds. Excellent for sauce, paste, juice, and canning. **Organic.**

Peppers: \$4. All of our seeds are bought from Heavenly Seed, LLC, in Anderson, SC.

Ancho Poblano (70 days): Large heart-shaped fruit, turns from green to red, 4-6" long. Sweet, distinctive flavor.

California Wonder (75 days): This large, thick-walled, juicy, sweet bell pepper is one of the most popular. 4" fruit turns bright red.

Carolina Cayenne (70 days): Home garden and commercial use. Fruit excellent for pickling, sauces, dehydration, and fresh market. Mature fruits are a bright, deep red and are quite pungent (80,000-100,000 SHU). Excellent yields.

Jaloro Jalapeno (70 days): Yellow jalapeno pepper developed by Texas A & M. Fruit is a beautiful golden yellow before turning orange then red, making for a beautiful show on compact plants. Just as hot as regular jalapenos.

Sweet Banana (65 days): Mild and sweet 6" fruits. Starts out yellow and will ripen to orange then red.

TAM Mild Jalapeno (65-70 days): Compact plants with multiple virus resistance. Strong pepper flavor and aroma make this pepper desirable for fresh consumption, pickling, or picante sauce. Mildly pungent (1100 SHU).
